# Forsyth-Monroe County Sports Hall of Fame

## *Frank Redding*



Lovette (Frank) Redding was a star running back for the Hubbard Tigers football team in the mid-1960s, and went on to a stellar career at Fort Valley State, where he is among the top rushers in School history. Despite being limited to eight games due to injury in 1968, as a fullback (No. 42) he still led the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC) with 1205 rushing yards (150.6 yards per game and 5.8 yards a carry), and with 14 touchdowns. He was drafted by the Kansas City Chiefs NFL team. Frank later served as Chief of the Forsyth Fire Department, and continues to live in Forsyth.
