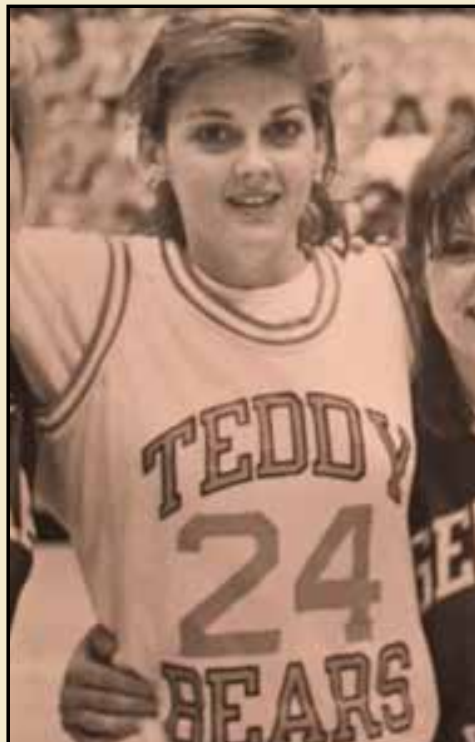

Rhonda Griffin Hardy



Rhonda Griffin was a multi-sport athlete during her high school career with Monroe Academy (1982-1985) as Region Champ in track the 400-yard dash, a four year starter in softball with All-Region MVP awards in her Sophomore, Junior and Senior seasons and All-State in her Junior and Senior seasons, was All-Region in her Sophomore year in basketball at MA, and MVP, All-Region and All-State for the State Champion Mustangs in her Junior and Senior years as well as having been selected to play in the North/South and Georgia/South Carolina All-Star games, and averaged 18 points and 10 rebounds per game as a Senior. Rhonda then went on to play multi-sports for Mercer University, as a Freshman and Sophomore playing basketball, softball (all-conference in Sophomore year), soccer and cross-country, and as a Junior and Senior playing basketball and softball for the Bears. She had 614 career assists in basketball (third all-time), and 366 assists in a single season (first all-time). Rhonda graduated from Mercer and has been an elementary school teacher for over 25 years, during which time she has coached softball and basketball at the varsity, junior varsity or middle-school level. She is married to Keith Hardy and they have two children, Kendall and Griffin.
