Mario Harvey



Mario Harvey was the fourth and most recent Mary Persons football alum to play in the National Football League. Harvey, who starred at linebacker for MP from 2002-2004 (in his senior season, he had 93 individual tackles, and a fumble recovery, and scored one offensive touchdown), went on to be named a two-time First Team All-Conference USA selection at Marshall University in 2009-2010. While a member of the Thundering Herd, Harvey amassed a whopping 421 tackles, including 21 sacks, and an interception. Mario then went on to play for the NFL's Indianapolis Colts from 2012-2014, appearing in 28 games while recording 27 tackles. Mario eventually returned to Forsyth where he has coached the popular travel football team, the Monroe Elite Tigers.
