*LaToya Davis*



LaToya Davis was a Mary Persons Basketball standout, Class of 2000, a two-time Class AA Player of the Year at MP, and USA Today Honorable Mention All-America pick from Mary Persons. During her MP career, according to an article in The Macon Telegraph, she scored 3426 points, averaging 26.5 points per game and 20 rebounds per game for her prep career. LaToya lettered four seasons playing for legendary Head Coach Pat Summitt at the University of Tennessee (2000-2004). As a forward at Tennessee, Davis was a member of UT Teams who each year during her career played in the NCAA Women's National Tournament and the record during that time during those four years was 124-17. The Volunteer Women reached the Final Four ending the 2002, 2003 and 2004 seasons, finishing second in the Nation in 2003 and 2004 and third in 2002. During the 2004 run to the National Championship game, LaToya was named to the Midwest region All-Tournament Team. During her senior year at UT, LaToya averaged 5.1 points per game and 3.2 rebounds per game.
